

REGISTRATION POLICIES (Updated December 15, 2021)

CLUB MEMBERSHIP AND CLASS REGISTRATION

Every athlete must purchase an annual membership payable in full at the time of enrollment. Annual fees are not pro-rated and are non-refundable. The yearly fees include membership to Gymnastics Canada, Gymnastics BC, and secondary accident insurance.

Recreational Programming:

The membership fees for the 2021-2022 season are \$67, which includes Gymnastics BC registration fees of \$42 and LGF membership fees of \$25.

A **\$25** fee will be charged for a declined credit card or returned cheques. Please remember to keep your credit card information online up to date or call the office for support.

Withdrawal Policy - Recreational (Gymnastics For All)

LGF will refund the training fees, minus \$25 for withdrawal done before the deadline. The last day to notify us of a withdrawal will be as follows.

Session 1 – September 30, 2021

Session 2 – February 28, 2022

No refunds will be issued after this date.

A full refund or credit will be given for a class should it be cancelled due to low numbers.

Transfers

Space permitting, transfers between classes are allowed. A \$10 administrative charge is applied.

Class / Camp Cancellations

Langley Gymnastics reserves the right to cancel classes with 3 or fewer athletes registered. Families will be notified via email, and athletes will have the option to transfer to other available classes with no penalty of transfer fees. If no suitable alternatives are found, a full refund will be issued.

Make-up, Credits and Refunds for Missed Class

Make-ups, credits, or refunds for missed classes (for any reason) are not available due to class schedules, ratios and building capacity restrictions. This includes holidays, competitions, school activities or occasional illness, extreme weather, or emergency closure (power outage, for example) and COVID-19 related quarantine, isolation or short-term closures (up to two weeks).

In times of extreme weather during weekdays, Langley Gymnastics' closure procedure aligns with that of the local public school district. If public schools are closed due to weather conditions, Langley Gymnastics classes are also cancelled. Please check local radio, television, and school board websites for school closures. An email will be sent to members to confirm the closure. Langley Gymnastics will monitor the situation and advise members via email if classes are cancelled during weekends.
